

## Connecting two Independent Clauses

An **independent clause** is a group of words which includes a subject and a verb, and contains a complete thought. Independent clauses can stand alone as sentences.

**Example:** Gregor is not interested in baseball. He is excited about basketball.

**Gregor is not interested in baseball, nor is he excited about basketball.**
