

Dividing Decimals - Word Problems

Solve each problem. Round the answer to two decimal places.

- 1) Mrs. Elizabeth Hawson deposits \$ 915.60 into her checking account. A week later, she writes her 3 grandchildren a check each. She splits the amount deposited in her checking account equally among her grandchildren. How much is each check worth?

- 2) A tropical cyclone uproots an old oak tree in Jamie's backyard. The trunk of the tree is cut into 12 equal pieces. Jamie chops the tree trunk into wood measuring 1.5 m long. How long is each piece of wood?

- 3) Alex is hosting a party at a local store. How much does he have to pay if Alex is billed \$ 65.40 for the party and he has to pay 10% of the bill?

- 4) Kate, a baker, uses 1.5 kg of flour to bake 27 vanilla sponge loaf cakes. How much flour is used for each loaf cake?

- 5) Gerard bought 7 DVDs in a Super Sunday Sale at a bookstore. If he paid \$125.72 for his purchase, how much did each DVD cost?
