

Dividing Decimals - Word Problems

Solve each problem. Round the answer to two decimal places.

- 1) Mrs. Elizabeth Hawson deposits £915.60 into her current account. A week later, she writes her 3 grandchildren a check each. She splits the amount deposited in her current account equally among her grandchildren. How much was each check worth?

- 2) A tropical cyclone uproots an old oak tree in Jamie's backyard. The trunk of the fallen oak tree is cut into 12 logs of equal length. How long is each log if the total length of the tree trunk was 120 meters?

- 3) Alex is hosting a party for 15 friends. He buys 15 drinks at the local cafe. Each drink costs £4.35. How much did he spend on the drinks?

- 4) Kate, a baker, made 12 vanilla sponge loaf cakes. She sold each loaf cake for £5.42. How much money did she make from selling the cakes?

- 5) Gerard bought 7 DVDs in a Super Sunday Sale at a bookstore. If he paid £69.93 for his purchase, how much did each DVD cost?
