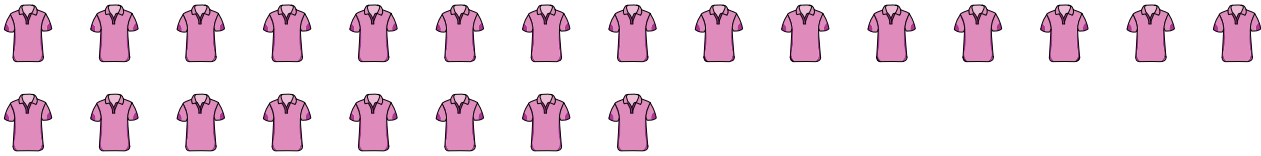


# Division Models

3) Divide into groups of 3.



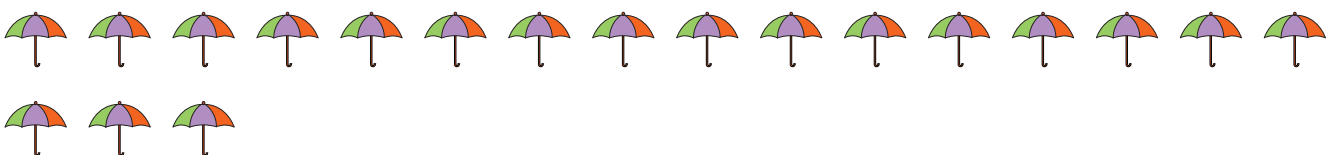
