- 1) A gardener plants three different saplings at East Green, Central Park . The number of magnolia saplings he planted was 3 less than crab apple saplings. The Kwanzan cherry saplings planted amounted to twice the number of magnolias. If 35 saplings were planted in all, how many Kwanzan cherry saplings he planted?

- 2) Mrs. Wilson's class was asked to paint clay figurines. There were 24 pots of paint in all, of which 6 pots were green paint. Besides, there were 2 more pots of blue paint. How many pots contained red paint?

- 3) Gina's mom filled 12 butter cups. The number of milk chocolate chocolates were 5 more than the number of dark chocolates and peanut butter chocolates. How many milk chocolates were there in all?

- 4) Emma, Noah and Mia go to a local preschool every day. Emma goes for twice as many hours as Noah. Mia goes for 3 hours in a week. How many hours did Emma go to school in a week?

- 5) The sum of three consecutive numbers is 141. Find the least and the greatest numbers in the series.

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
