A) Arrange each set of like fractions in increasing order.

1) $4\frac{2}{3}$, $5\frac{1}{3}$, $1\frac{2}{3}$, $3\frac{1}{3}$

2) $6\frac{5}{11}$, $2\frac{3}{11}$, $3\frac{4}{11}$, $8\frac{10}{11}$

3) $3\frac{9}{14}$, $9\frac{5}{14}$, $6\frac{3}{14}$

$9\frac{2}{5}$, $9\frac{4}{5}$, $9\frac{1}{5}$

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B) Arrange each set

1) $8\frac{3}{7}$, $4\frac{1}{7}$, $8\frac{6}{7}$

$6\frac{3}{8}$, $6\frac{1}{8}$, $6\frac{5}{8}$

3) $10\frac{3}{4}$, $12\frac{3}{4}$, $11\frac{3}{4}$, $15\frac{3}{4}$

4) $4\frac{6}{15}$, $2\frac{8}{15}$, $9\frac{2}{15}$, $10\frac{3}{15}$
