Adams had trained to be a pianist when he was young. However, his love for the outdoors and photography soon became more important. He loved climbing mountains. He was the first person to climb some of the peaks in the Sierra Nevada.

In 1932, Adams co-founded a photography group. It was called f/64. Here, he developed zone exposure. This method helped photographers get maximum tonal range with black and white film.

As time went on Adams'photographs became famous. They presented awesome landscapes. They included Yosemite in California and the Grand Canyon of Arizona.

Today, copies of his photos can be seen in many places. You may have seen some in National Park visitor centers. If not, you can find them in books or on the internet.

Some people criticized Adams for not including humans in most of his nature photos. They said his photography showed a wilderness that was disappearing.
