## Zero Conditionals

The zero conditional refers to general habits or scientific truths. We use the simple present tense in both parts of a zero-conditional sentence.

Zero conditionals are formed with "if" or "when".

**Example:** you/freeze water/turn into ice

**If you freeze water, it turns into ice.**
