## **Conditionals**

To form a zero conditional, we use the simple present tense in both clauses. Zero conditionals are formed with "if" or "when".

To form a first conditional, we use the present simple in the "if/when" clause and the future simple in the other clause.

To form a second conditional, we use the past simple in the "if" clause and "would/could" and infinitive in the other clause.

**Example:** If we travel extensively, we learn a lot.
