Double Negatives

Double negatives are using two negatives in a phrase or sentence. When we use negative words such as no, nobody and nothing in a sentence, we don't generally use a negative verb. Otherwise, the sentence would be considered faulty.

Example: She didn't read nothing.

She didn't read anything.

She read nothing.
