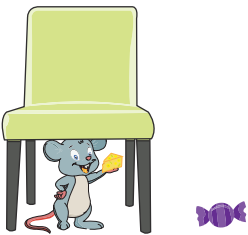
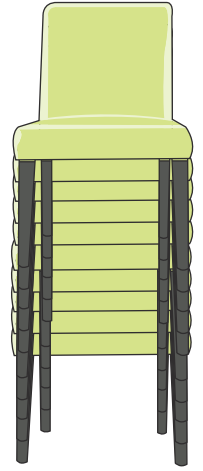
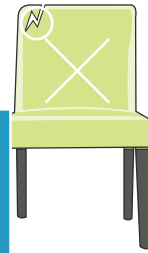


Bob's Chair Job
