Plural Possessive Nouns

Plural nouns that end with "s" are made possessive by an apostrophe being added to the end.

Example: The knives' blades are blunt. (knives)

Irregular plural nouns that don't end with "s" are changed into possessive by an apostrophe and an "s" being added to the end.

Example: The children's section of the library has many books. (children)
