**Past Perfect:** It expresses an action that is completed before another action in the past.

Example: Tony had finished the porridge before Lily came home.

**Past Perfect Progressive:** It refers to an action that started in the past and continued to another time in the past.

Example: Alice had been talking to her friends daily before she lost her phone.
