

# Civil Rights Acts

Match each Act to its correct provision.

1. Civil Rights Act of 1866

- prohibits employment discrimination
- based on race, color, sex, religion or national origin.

2. Civil Rights Act of 1875

prohibits employment discrimination and allows federal suits and allows federal suits against those who suppress the rights of all citizens by force, law, or custom.

3. Civil Rights Act of 1957

prohibits employment discrimination based on race, color, sex, religion or national origin. It also provides for the right of all citizens born in the United States to register and vote.

4. Voting Rights Act of 1965

prohibits employment discrimination based on race, color, sex, religion or national origin. It also provides for the right of all citizens born in the United States to register and vote.

5. Fair Housing Act of 1968

- legally established the Civil Rights Commission (CRC) which was created to provide equal rights to all citizens of the nation.
- prohibits employment discrimination
