**Term of Office:** 1797 – 1801

**Interesting Facts:** John Adams was the first to sign the Declaration of Independence.

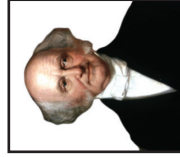

**Born:** November 24, 1784

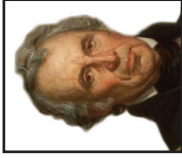

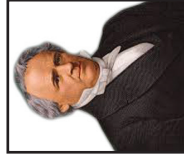
