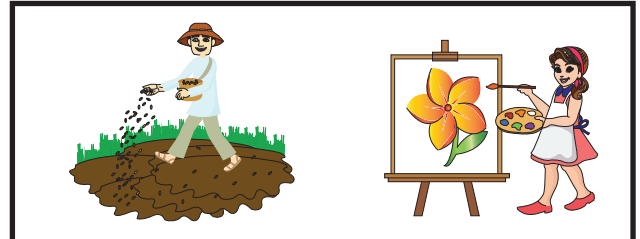


Producers and Consumers
