

## Converting from Celsius to Fahrenheit

Convert the temperatures from Celsius to Fahrenheit using the formula.

Example: Convert 24 °C to °F.

$$F = 1.8 C + 32$$

$$= 1.8 (24) + 32 = 43.2 + 32 = 75.2 \text{ °F}$$
