

Converting from Fahrenheit to Celsius

Example: Convert 68 °F to °C.

$$C = \frac{5}{9} (F - 32)$$

$$= \frac{5}{9} (68 - 32) = \frac{5}{9} (36) = 20 \text{ °C}$$
