

Converting from Fahrenheit to Celsius

Convert the temperatures from Fahrenheit to Celsius using the formula. Round your answers to the nearest tenth.

Example: Convert 78 °F to °C.

$$C = \frac{5}{9} (F - 32)$$

$$= \frac{5}{9} (78 - 32) = \frac{5}{9} (46) = 25.6 \text{ °C}$$
