Misplaced Modifiers

For the meaning of a sentence to be clear, it is important that its modifiers are in the right place. A modifier put in the wrong place is called a misplaced modifier.

Example: Smith saw a cat on the way back from school.

It seems that the cat was on its way back from school and not Smith, which is not the case. So the sentence should be corrected as

On the way back from school, Smith saw a cat.
