Complex Sentences

A **complex sentence** is a sentence formed with an independent clause and at least one dependent (subordinate) clause.

Example: Maria bought a new jacket, because she was attending a wedding.

"Maria bought a new jacket" is an independent clause.

"because she was attending a wedding" is a dependent clause.
